Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8955c) affecting the Tuttington Footpath 3 from its junction with Church Lane for 140m southwards (the "Footpath A") and: Brampton Footpath 3 from its junction with Tuttington Footpath 3 for 20m southwards (hereinafter referred to as "the Footpath B") and: Brampton Footpath 4 from its junction with Brampton Footpath 3 for 20m eastwards (hereinafter referred to as "the Footpath C") in the Parish of Burgh and Tuttington to facilitate Norfolk County Council cradle footbridge replacement works. The Footpaths A-C will be temporarily closed for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from from 17th February to 18th April 2025 only whilst signs indicating closures are in place, but may continue to be closed until the 18th October 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 18th October 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Footpaths A-C in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
