Des Fulcher began by saying that he must receive a deposit of £500 to secure the date for the fireworks. Giles Margarson proposed that this would be paid immediately from the Events Committee funds, this was agreed by the committee. Following a visit to the Recreation Ground Des Fulcher suggested the preferred site for the fireworks would be the tennis courts. Donna Butcher advised that this would not be possible as part of the event is for the sports groups to open up their facilities therefore the tennis courts would be in use. It was agreed that a better site would be down near the skate park area.

## 9. TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON PLANS FOR SATURDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> JUNE

Patrick Prekopp updated the committee on the plans for the Cittaslow Snail Colouring Competition. All schools have got involved as have the Library. It was agreed not to call it a competition therefore no need for judging. The finished snails are to be returned to the Council office no later than Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May and will be displayed in the Town Hall under 'Exhibition of Children's Artwork'.

## 10. TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON PLANS FOR SUNDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> JUNE

Donna Butcher reported that the Street Party has been closed at 1048 people attending, with currently 50 on the reserve list. It was suggested that we may be able to accommodate more people if we have enough tables and chairs. Plans are being made to purchase 300 foldable chairs, these will then be offered for use in the community with a deposit paid. The Town Council and Recreation Ground are looking to purchase more tables for general use which can be used for the Street Party.
